REVIEW

Barbara said that Volunteer Day is scheduled for June 27th (it will be the last Saturday of June each year). Barbara said that she still needs to check about vendor times for Heritage Days.

DISC GOLF

Jason said that this sport is continuing to grow. The World Championships will be held this year in Ogden at Fort Buenaventura and at Toads. The 13 to 20 professionals will be here in June. The week prior will be for amateurs. Jason got some points of contact and has been talking to several vendors. We could set up a tournament, shotgun start, 5 players per hole for a total of 45 people, at a cost of \$30 per person per day. We could get 50 Frisbees plus extras for prizes. If we had 45 players, that would be \$1,350, less \$597.50 for the Frisbees. The glow Frisbees would be \$10.15 each, plus a custom stamp cost of \$90. We could use any difference between costs and expenses for prizes, shirts, etc. We can set up the teams by gender, age, or however we want to since this wouldn't be a sanctioned tournament. He said that he had talked to Bruce in Recreation and there is no budget for a tournament like this. Mr. Cluff said that it would have to be a city-sponsored tournament and money could be budgeted for it. However, he feels this course is more for kids and amateurs. Adults and older kids might not be interested. An activity for a family is a good idea though. Jason said he would be happy to work with Bruce if needed. He said we wouldn't advertise to the pros, on Facebook, etc., but could post something on the message boards and the newsletter to see if there was an interest in such a tournament. He suggested that the stamp on the Frisbees could be the clock tower with "Clinton City Tournament 2020" printed on them so people would have something to keep. Mr. Cluff suggested that maybe we could do it with Heritage Days, instead of Halloween. Terry suggested that Barbara bring this up at the Heritage Days committee meeting.

Motion by Justin to propose a 9-hole tournament with the date to be determined. Seconded by Jason. Motion carried.

It was suggested that a kids tournament be tried and see how it goes, then future plans can be determined for other tournaments. Jason said he would get more information on lower prices, lower fees, etc.
