

# SIGN UP OR UPDATE YOUR EMERGENCY CONTACT & NOTIFICATION INFORMATION

Clinton City's emergency contact and notification system is a great tool to keep the community informed of important information or in the event of an emergency. If you have already signed up, it is a good idea to log on and make sure your information is accurate. If you have not yet registered, now is the time. To register, click on the Red Phone (below) to follow the link to our website at www.clintoncity.com.



or, go to the website and click on the Red Phone to sign up. By registering, you can specify how you will receive notifications and you can keep your profile updated with accurate contact information to insure you are notified of important information or of an emergency.

Please note that our Emergency Contact System is automatically and regularly updated through our Utility Billing System. If your information on file is not accurate, and you have not registered on our website, you may not receive EMERGENCY NOTICES through our system. Please call our Utilities Department at 801-614-0700 to update your information.

If you are an owner of a rental property, please encourage your renters to register for notifications through our website as only home owners are notified through the billing system.

When registering, please make sure to <u>respond</u> to the verification email to complete the registration process.
