We are in need of volunteers, 18 years of age or older to help our community kids learn how to fish. This is a great way to get involved with the community, help out our youth, and acquire volunteer "dedicated hunter" hours. Training and materials will be provided and background checks are mandatory.

### Winter Driving Safety Tips

During the winter, inclement weather and resulting unsafe road conditions add to the unusual hazards of driving. Normal safe driving habits should be modified to allow for these changing conditions.

Winter driving conditions also put more strain on vehicles no matter what traffic problems drivers may face: so it's important to make sure that your vehicle doesn't break down and complicate things further. Make sure your headlights and tail lights are working properly, including turn signals, brightness and alignment. Replace worn out windshield wipers and keep the fluid system filled—if you can't see a hazard, you can't avoid it. Make sure you have emergency tools and materials in the trunk for unexpected trouble. These include a flashlight, flares, battery cables, an empty gas can, blankets, work gloves, a bag of sand, and a shovel.

It's also a good idea to have supplies in the trunk for you and your passengers in the event that you become stranded in a winter storm, especially if you are traveling a long distance:

- Extra blankets and/or sleeping bags
- Extra Clothing
- Non perishable food
- Drinking water
- Matches, candles and/or solid fuels
- Sand or cat litter which can be used for traction
- An axe to cut tree branches which can be used for traction.

Also with these freezing temperatures always expect **BLACK ICE**. Slow down and drive with care. Allowing distance between you and the car ahead will allow you time to react.

### CLINTON CITY CLOCK TOWER RELOCATION SURVEY

Due to the sale of the old city park; the relocation of city facilities to the new land site to the north; and future development of commercial businesses on the old city park property; the Clock Tower must be relocated. Clinton City is seeking public input in deciding where to relocate this beautiful City Clock Tower to provide all residents with the best opportunity to enjoy it.

Four locations are currently under consideration (if you have a better option, please let us know). The four locations are:

- ( ) Center of the new round-about at 2300 N 1500 W,
- ( ) The new Clinton City Park between the new fire and police buildings along 1500 W.
- ( ) The new Clinton City Park family activity area in the north west section of the park.
- ( ) On 1800 N either west or east of its current location.
